Historical Sketch

First Baptist Church traces its origins to three Black families that escaped north to “free Kansas” and began worshipping together near the Kaw and Missouri Rivers in 1859. As the congregation grew, it split into two denominations that eventually became the First A.M.E. Church and the First Baptist Church, both of Kansas City, Kansas. The congregation of First Baptist Church, under the leadership of Rev. Joseph Strater, worshipped in a storefront at 5th and Washington. The congregation moved to its present location at 500 Nebraska Avenue in 1879. The original building was demolished and rebuilt in 1913.

Scope and Content Note

The First Baptist Church Collection primarily consists of meeting minutes of the First Baptist Church Sewing Circle covering the period 1920-1955 and minutes from general

business meetings covering the period 1957-1996. There are gaps in the coverage. The collection also contains church directories, funeral programs, sheet music and song lyrics, anniversary programs, and miscellaneous documents, including a business card for Rev. Edward A. Freeman.

The collection also includes four photographs. An oversize photograph of an unidentified church group has been withdrawn to Oversize Box #1; a panoramic group photograph of attendees at the 32nd Annual Missionary Baptist Convention held at First Baptist Church in 1923 has been withdrawn to Map Drawer #1.
