## *Historical Sketch*

The Jazz District Redevelopment Corporation (JDRC) entered into a memorandum of agreement with the Missouri State Historic Preservation Program and the City of Kansas City, Missouri, in January 2000. The agreement required the JDRC to complete baseline documentation of buildings owned by the corporation that form part of the 18<sup>th</sup> & Vine National Historic District prior to their renovation or reconstruction. The building surveys were prepared by Historic Preservation Services, LLC and completed in December 2000.

## *Scope and Content Note*

This collection consists of documentation and photographs of four buildings owned by the Jazz District Redevelopment Corporation that form part of the 18<sup>th</sup> & Vine National

Register Historic District: 1511-13 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street; 1514 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street; 1619-27 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street; and 1705-11 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The documentation includes narrative physical descriptions, property histories, and sketch floor plans. The collection includes photographs for 1511-13 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street; 1514 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street; and 1619-27 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street. Only one photograph exists for 1705-11 E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The collection also includes a letter from Historic Preservation Services, LLC to Pamela Ross, Executive Director of the Black Archives of Mid-America, delivered with the surveys.
