

Midwest Afro-American Genealogical Interest Coalition (M.A.G.I.C.) and Highland Cemetery Records Collection (AC61)

Introduction:

The Midwest Afro-American Genealogical Interest Coalition (M.A.G.I.C.) and Highland Cemetery Collection contains M.A.G.I.C. organizational records and a variety of records for genealogical research. The bulk of the collection consists of burial records from Highland Cemetery, a local historically Black cemetery.

Subseries 10.12.1- Subseries 10.12.8, Subseries 10.12.10, and Series 11- Series 13 were digitized by Family Search in late 2025- early 2026. These records are available on the Family Search website: <https://www.familysearch.org/en/records/images/search-results?projectId=M9PX-1JK&page=1>.

According to Missouri State law, personal records must be at least 50 years old before they may be placed online, therefore, some records are not currently available, but new records will be made available each year as they pass the 50 year benchmark. A special thanks goes to Michael and Karla Hinckley and Leland and Bonnie Kofford for digitizing these records. The hard drive holding these images has also been added to this collection and is available to researchers. Lastly, the Black Archives of Mid-America, Jackson County Land Trust, and Charter Funerals at Mt. Washington Cemetery in KCMO will work together to produce a searchable database of these digitized records.

Original Language Statement:

The Black Archives of Mid-America follows the widespread practice of using the language provided by speakers and writers of historical documents. Using the speaker's or writer's language can be very informative and provide pivotal contextual information about cultural and societal customs of previous time periods. As a result, researchers may encounter descriptive language, which often includes verbiage that contains obvious bias, or outdated and stereotypical terminology, and/ or content. Contemporary readers and researchers might find this language harmful or offensive.

Historical Sketch:***M.A.G.I.C.-***

Midwest Afro-American of Genealogical Interest Coalition (M.A.G.I.C.) formed in 1991, led by Dorothy Witherspoon, Dr. Collins Anderson, Jr., Audrey McKinnie-Hunter, Bertha Johnson, Gwendolyn Richards, Kim Tucker-Paige, and Jacqueline Briggs, to promote genealogy among the heartland's African American community. This group was preceded by the Kansas City, Missouri Historical and Genealogical Society, founded by Dr. Collins F. Anderson, Jr., Elvis Gibson, and Artie Criswell, in 1984, whose purpose was to promote black genealogy. M.A.G.I.C. is still operating today. They host monthly meetings for their members, and formerly produced a quarterly newsletter called *Generations*.

Highland Cemetery-

In February 1909, John and Frances Eames sold 29 acres to the Highland Cemetery Company, made up of local prominent Kansas Citizens: Dr. T. C. Unthank, Reverend J.W. Hurse of St. Stephens Baptist Church, Prof. T. W. H. Williams, C. H. Countee, Reverend T. H. Ewing of Vine Street Baptist Church, Dr. J. E. Perry, Reverend R. Davis of Central Methodist Church, Reverend W. H. Peck of Allen Chapel M. E. Church, and A. T. Moore. This was the first private cemetery in Kansas City for African American citizens. It was designed by prominent, local landscape architect, Sidney (Sid) Hare. With the end of segregation in 1964, the cemetery saw fewer burials and fell into disrepair. Context clues show that Highland Cemetery shared office space with Highland Cemetery beginning in the mid-1970s, if not earlier.

Finally, in 2010, due to failure to pay taxes, the property went into foreclosure and fell under the control of the Jackson County Land Trust. Highland Cemetery burial records were recovered from an abandoned trailer at Blue Ridge Cemetery in the late 2010s; M.A.G.I.C. took possession of these records, then donated them to the Black Archives. Additional burial records from the 1960s-1970s were recovered at a second abandoned trailer at Bue Ridge Cemetery in early summer 2025.

Scope and Content Note:

[OS] indicates an item that is oversized. All oversized items have been removed to Box 13, except for the framed portrait, which hangs on the wall with the Collections rooms; the ledger [Box 68. **Note this artifact may also contain inactive mold**]; and the oversized maps [Box 69 and Box 70]. **Records**

containing inactive mold have been removed to Box 45. All restricted records have been removed to Box 7. Researchers will have access to redacted copies.

This collection is organized thematically, with M.A.G.I.C. organization records first, followed by cemetery records, and then other death related records. The Highland Cemetery Records have been organized chronologically. Every effort was made to keep all records as close to their original order as possible.

Series 1: M.A.G.I.C.

This series contains organizational records produced by MAGIC. The initial MAGIC institutional records, 1991-2017, were donated by Preston Washington c. 2023, while David Jackson, a former member of the MAGIC, donated additional MAGIC institutional records dating to the founding of the group up to 2023.

Subseries 1.1: Organizational Records, 1991-2023

This subseries is primarily organized by year, including reports, membership lists, meeting minutes, agendas, and other organizational activity records. It also includes a 501c3 application, a tax-exempt application, the constitution and bylaws, and a business application. The papers within individual files have been kept in their original form as much as possible. [Note: This series contains restricted files due to sensitive information and is not available for reproduction. These records have been removed to Box 2.]

Subseries 1.2: Financial Records, 1994-2010

This subseries contains financial records of MAGIC. [Note: This series contains 1 restricted file due to sensitive information and is not available for reproduction.]

Subseries 1.3: Newsletters, 1991-2020

This subseries of copies of the *Generations* newsletters produced by MAGIC dates from 1991-2020.

Subseries 1.4: Miscellaneous Records

This subseries contains miscellaneous histories, flyers, and publications produced by M.A.G.I.C., as well as information related to the African American Historical and Genealogical Society (AAHGS).

Subseries 1.5: Correspondence

This subseries contains correspondence to M.A.G.I.C.

Subseries 1.6: Artifacts

This series features a M.A.G.I.C. ink stamp.

Subseries 1.7: Photographs, 1996-2004

This subseries features photographs of members of M.A.G.I.C. Print 1 is from 1996; Print 2-7 is from 1997; Prints 8-46 are from the M.A.G.I.C. Seminar in 1998; Prints 47-60 are from 2000; and Print 61 is from 2004.

Series 2: Publications

This series contains published works by historians and published research by members of MAGIC.

Series 3: Family Histories

This series contains compiled family histories M.A.G.I.C. members.

Series 4: Historical and Genealogical Research

This series contains research materials gathered by members of M.A.G.I.C. on various aspects of Black history. Files include correspondence, newspaper clippings, marriage certificates, other certificates, and ancestry research and records. There are also files on genealogical research and on available research resources.

Subseries 4.1: MAGIC Members

This subseries contains personal genealogy research conducted by members of MAGIC. [Note: This series contains 1 restricted file due to sensitive information and is not available for reproduction.]

Subseries 4.2: Other Research

This subseries contains research by MAGIC on a variety of genealogy topics. Much of this section is focused on KC history or genealogical research. [OS] indicated oversized material that has been removed and relocated to Box 11.

Series 5: Newspapers and Magazines, 1977-2020

This series contains newspapers, newspaper clippings, and magazines. [OS] indicates the item is oversized and that the item has been removed and relocated to Box 11.

Subseries 5.1: Newspapers, 2001-2019

This subseries contains whole newspapers.

Subseries 5.2: Newspaper Clippings, n.d., 1849-2018

This subseries contains newspaper clippings from the *KC Star* (1880-Present), *The Call* (1919-Present), *The Rising Sun* (1903-1907), *Living Omaha World- Herald* (1885-2020), and *Atlanta Journal- Constitution* (1950-Present). As well as scans of articles.

Subseries 5.3: Magazines, 2009-2020

This subseries contains four different magazines, including a collector's edition of *Ebony* from 2009 with former President Barack Obama on the cover as Person of the Year.

Series 6: Elvis "Sonny" Gibson

This series contains published works of Sonny Gibson's, a local, Black KC historian, *Mecca of the New Negro*, which focuses on forgotten stories of Black KC history, published in 1997. This series also contains *Life, Time and Events of Past Kansas City* and *1865 Kansas City Early Negro History* published in 2014.

Series 7: Obituaries, 2005-2008

This series contains obituaries newspaper clippings from *The Call*, Kansas City's first Black-owned and run newspaper. Each page features multiple obituaries. They were compiled by members of M.A.G.I.C. between 2005-2008 and are arranged alphabetically within each year.

Series 8: Funeral Programs

This series contains funeral programs for members of the Black community in KC, such as Rev. D.A. Holmes, Harold Holliday, Horace Peterson III, Bernard Powell, and W. L. Jones, and is arranged alphabetically by last name. It also contains a program in honor of MLK, and the funeral program of President Theodore Roosevelt in 1919, in California.

Series 9: Funeral Home Records

This series contains records and histories from the Watkins Funeral Home and Mrs. Meek's Mortuary.

Series 10: Cemetery Histories & Records

This series contains histories and other records related to eleven identified cemeteries: Hope, Lincoln, Elmwood, Union, Forest Hill & Calvary, Leed's, Blue Ridge Memorial, Memorial Park, Leavenworth National, Woodlawn, and Highland. It also contains records for an unidentified cemetery. Lastly, each cemetery subseries contains records of funerals. The records from Highland Cemetery are the most extensive and contain original documents from the cemetery itself, including deeds, permits, certificates, memorial agreements, and internment cards.

Subseries 10.1: Hope Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Hope Cemetery, located at 3600 Parallel Parkway Kansas City, Kansas, and borders Quindaro Cemetery. This cemetery is under the jurisdiction of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County; its records are maintained by the Wyandotte County Museum in KCK. No other information is available currently.

Subseries 10.2: Lincoln Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Lincoln Cemetery, 8604 East Truman Road, Kansas City, MO 64126, one of three Black cemeteries in KC, opened in 1934. Legendary jazz musician, Charlie "The Bird" Parker is buried at Lincoln. No other information is available currently.

Subseries 10.3: Elmwood Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Elmwood Cemetery. Located at 4900 E Truman Rd, Kansas City, MO 64127, Elmwood was originally a private cemetery and opened in 1872. The Elmwood Cemetery Society, led by Kirkland B. Armour, S.B. Armour, A.R. Meyer, W.J. Smith, and George H. Nettleton, formed in 1896. Much of the landscaping was designed by famed KC architect and landscape artist, George Kessler. It is still an active cemetery, comprised of 43 acres. Elmwood was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1983 for architecture, landscape architecture, and urban design.

Subseries 10.4: Union Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Union Cemetery. Union Cemetery, at 227 East 28th Terrace, Kansas City, Missouri 64108, founded in 1857, is the oldest cemetery in Kansas City, Missouri. Contrary to popular belief, this cemetery was not originally established as a final resting place for Union Civil War soldiers, nor is it named for the Union. It was simply a public cemetery. It was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2016, today the 27 acres of the cemetery are cared for by the Union Cemetery Historical Society, a non-profit that formed in 1984.

Subseries 10.5: Forest Hill & Calvary Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Forst Hill & Calvary Cemetery. Forest Hill & Calvary, 6901 Troost Ave, Kansas City, MO 64131, near the site of the Battle of Westport, was established in 1888. George Kessler also served as the landscape architect for this cemetery; and Sid Hare served as the cemetery's first superintendent; Hare went on to work for J. C. Nichols.

Subseries 10.6: Leeds Cemetery

This subseries consists of records related to Leeds Cemetery. Leeds, Eastwood Hills, a Potter's Field at Municipal Farms, opened in 1911 after Union Cemetery closed its Potter's Field. A Potter's Field is a common grave designated for the remains of unidentified people. It was located southwest of the Truman Sports Complex. Today the cemetery is divided in two by I-435. Construction for I-435 began in 1966; it was completed in 1987.

Subseries 10.7: Blue Ridge Lawn Memorial Gardens Cemetery

This subseries consists of records from the Blue Ridge Lawn Memorial Gardens. Address: 2640 Blue Ridge Blvd, Kansas City, 64129. This cemetery was established in 1925 as a "park plan." It was developed by United Cemetery Company with George Post and Sons in charge of architecture and Charles D. Woodward of Tuttle-Ayres-Woodward on Landscaping. This is one of the three Black cemeteries along Blue Ridge Blvd, the other two being Highland Cemetery and Lincoln Cemetery. However, Blue Ridge Memorial is the only one that had an endowment.

This subseries contains records related to one William Pero (unknown-1951), including Deeds, Receipts, and page of notes that Mr. Pero was buried in Highland, however, all other records specify his plot lay in Blue Ridge Lawn Cemetery.

Subseries 10.8: Memorial Park Cemetery

This subseries contains the record of funeral for Chester A. Warfield, 1979. Memorial Park is located at 8251 Hillcrest Rd, Kansas City, 64138. Bernard DeVry established this cemetery in 1922. In 1964, H.W. “Bill” DeVry Jr. bought Green Lawn Cemetery, located at 81st and Hillcrest and the established Park Lawn Funeral Homes at 83rd and Hillcrest. Today, the DeVry family runs Memorial Park, Green Lawn, and Glenridge Cemeteries.

Subseries 10.9: Leavenworth National Cemetery

This subseries contains the record of the funeral for Thomas Bates, 1969. Located at 150 Muncie Rd, Leavenworth, KS 66048. This cemetery is solely for members of the armed forces and their families and remains active today. Originally, this land was a Delaware reservation and then a Stockbridge Baptist Mission. The cemetery and, what is now, the National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, was established in 1886.

Subseries 10.10: Woodlawn Cemetery

This subseries contains records of burials for Woodlawn Cemetery. Woodlawn, located at 701 S Nold Rd, Independence, MO 64050, founded in 1837, is the oldest cemetery in continuous use in Jackson County, Missouri. Bess Truman’s (wife of President Harry Truman) mother, father, and grandparents at buried at Woodlawn. It also contains a Confederate memorial.

Subseries 10.11: unidentified cemetery records

This subseries consists of records of funerals and handwritten notes on burials for an unknown cemetery. This subseries also contains handwritten records related to monuments; however, the cemetery is unknown.

Subseries 10.12: Highland Cemetery, 1909-2016

This subseries consists of various records from Highland Cemetery, including burial permits, record of burials, internment record cards, lot owner cards, lot cards, contracts, and maps. Highland, located at 1924 Blue Ridge Blvd Kansas City, Missouri 64126, began in 1909 and was one of three private cemeteries open to Black Kansas Citians. In 2017, M.A.G.I.C. formed the Highland Cemetery Preservation Group, a community activism group focused on preserving the cemetery, to maintain and preserve burial records from Highland. The Preservation Group, led by Pam Hider Johnson,

Michael O'Shiver, and Jennifer Enderson, sought to bring the property out of receivership, the transfer of control of a property's management to a neutral third party, and to create a 501c3. They were also in the process of marking veteran's gravesites, restoration, and repair of gravestones, and establish continued maintenance of the property, until March 2019.

Subseries 10.12.1: Highland Cemetery History & Research, 1944-2014

This subseries contains research, correspondence, a history of Highland, and financial records for the Concerned Citizens for Highland Cemetery.

Subseries 10.12.2: Lot Owner Cards

This subseries contains original 3x5 plot owner cards for Highland Cemetery. Plot owner cards list the name of the person who bought the plot, not everyone who is buried in the plot. These are in order by the individual's last name. Many of the cards are brittle.

Subseries 10.12.3: Block Cards

This subseries contains original 3x5 lot cards. Lot cards list the names of those buried in each lot aka plot. These are in numerical order by Lot number. Many of the cards are brittle. Some Lot cards are missing, and Block 2, Block 5, and Block 9 are missing entirely, nearly all of Blocks 11 and 12 are also missing.

Subseries 10.12.4: Internment Cards, 1909-1955

This subseries contains original 3x5 cards that list each burial and contain additional information about each individual. These are the original organizational scheme by which burials were recorded. They are organized by date. Highland Cemetery switched from 3x5 index cards to 8x10 sheets of paper in 1955. These cards were kept as separate subseries due to their distinct form. Many of the cards are brittle.

Subseries 10.12.5: Internment Records, 1955-2016

This subseries contains original and scanned copies of records related to burials at Highland Cemetery from 1955-2016. These records include the deceased person's name, the date they were buried, the lot and block number, and usually a relative's name and address. Highland Cemetery switched from 3x5 index cards to 8x10 sheets of paper c. 1955.

When donated, these records existed within multiple organization schemes: (1) Records from 1956-1961, a combination of internment records and invoices, were originally together in a 2- prong book, are fragile, (2) Photocopies or recreated copies (and some originals) of the internment records from 1978-2016 previously resided in 5 large 3-ring binders. Burial records in the later 2000s are sporadic. Records from the 1960s-1990s are often accompanied by the individual's obituary or funeral program. (3) 3 boxes of records from 1949-2002 were organized first by year then alphabetically by individual's last name. (4) 3 boxes of records were simply organized alphabetically. And lastly, (5) 11 binders, 1 ledger, and some loose pages of records from the 1960s recovered in June 2025. These records were donated to the Archives in January 2026.

Be aware that original creators skipped Internment Records #15101-15999, Internment Records #16101-16999, Internment Records #17000-17999, and Internment Records #18100-18999. Additionally, three of the original books were nearly burned, at some point, and as a result the edges of these pages still contain evidence of the fire. [Note: F. 650-697 are fragile and will be restricted due to their physical state. Researchers may access digital images of these records found in Series 16.] [Also Note: This series contains records that may contain inactive mold.] Every effort was made to keep all records as close to their original order as possible.

Subseries 10.12.6: Individual Internment and Related Records, 1943-2011

This subseries contains the original and photocopies records from 1943-2011 that were organized first by year then alphabetically by individual's last name, or records that were simply organized alphabetically, as listed in the previous subseries. The records contain a variety of record types including applications, internment records, deeds, memorial orders, permits, obituaries, and other related records. These records are primarily originals, but there are many scans as well. Context clues suggest that someone, or a group of people, not originally associated with Highland Cemetery, reorganized these records, pulling together multiple types of records for the deceased into individual files. Every effort was made to keep these records in as close to the order in which they were delivered to us as possible; however, to assist researchers, these records are now all organized first by year of death, then by individual's last name. [Note: This series contains files restricted due to sensitive personal information and are not available for reproduction.]

Subseries 10.12.7: Applications and Deeds, n.d., 1933-1947, 1973-1980

This subseries contains original Contracts for Deeds between Highland Cemetery and Kansas Citians. Contracts for Deeds are legal documents concerning the purchase of real estate, in this case, the purchase of burial plots. These are organized by date. This subseries also contains scanned copies of applications for purchase of plots. They were originally housed in a 3-ring binder. They are now organized by date.

Subseries 10.12.8: Memorial Orders, 1948-1981

This subseries contains original memorial agreements with Highland Cemetery and order forms for headstones from the Kansas City Monument Company, 4801 Truman Rd, KCMO, or the Jenkins Music Company, 1217 Walnut St., KCMO, as well as from Sears, Roebuck and Co. These records track the order and installation of gravestones, markers, and monuments and include the following information: billing, scheduling, the name of the deceased, the date of their burial, and the location of their grave. Additionally, some of these records are handwritten explanations of orders for memorials/ monuments for veterans, rather than a form, and the company from which they originated is not listed. All of these records are organized by date. [NOTE: some of these records are incredibly fragile.] This collection also contains original installation orders from Highland Cemetery.

Subseries 10.12.9: Miscellaneous

This subseries contains a budget for 1967-1968 of unknown origin, and a blank timecard. They were originally found amongst the Plot Owner Cards. It also includes a second blank timecard (with writing on the back) and a business card for Heckendorn MFG. Co., Inc., which was originally found among the internment cards.

Subseries 10.12.10: Financial Records and Receipts, 1960-1974

This subseries contains original and scanned copies of purchase receipts of plots within Highland, as well as scanned copies of record of payment, and a payment ledger. [Note: This series contains records that may contain inactive mold.]

Subseries 10.12.11: Correspondence, 1931-1972

This subseries contains correspondence to and from Highland Cemetery.

Subseries 10.12.12: Maps

This subseries contains original oversized maps of Highland Cemetery. They are oversized and have been placed in rolled storage containers. [Note: This series contains 2 restricted files due to physical deterioration. Access is not available. However, a copy of the Garden of Devotion map has been included within the collection.]

Series 11: Death Certificates, 1910-1959

This series contains scans of death certificates produced by Jackson County, Missouri from 1910-1959. They are sorted first by the cemetery where the deceased was buried, then by date.

Subseries 11.1: Leeds Cemetery, 1912-1958

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Leeds Cemetery. Leeds was also known as Municipal Cemetery.

Subseries 11.2: Union Cemetery, 1910-1955, n.d.

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Union Cemetery.

Subseries 11.3: Elmwood, 1919-1934

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Elmwood Cemetery.

Subseries 11.4 Highland Cemetery, 1943-1949

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Highland Cemetery.

Subseries 11.5: Blue Ridge Lawn Memorial, 1933-1958

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Blue Ridge Memorial Cemetery.

Subseries 11.6: Maple Hill Cemetery, 1933-1944

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Maple Hill Cemetery.

Subseries 11.7: Lincoln Cemetery, 1943, 1958

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials at Lincoln Cemetery.

Subseries 11.8: Lee's Summit, 1912

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials in Lee's Summit.

Subseries 11.9: Mt. Calvary, 1945-1951

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with burials in Mt. Calvary.

Subseries 11.10: Indeterminate, 1916-1955

This subseries contains scans of death certificates without a cemetery or crematorium listed, or where it was not possible to determine the cemetery or crematorium.

Subseries 11.11: Hospitals & Schools, 1933-1958

This subseries contains scans of death certificates with cremations at General Hospital No 1, KU Med, the KC Dental College, and the KC College of Osteopathy, or the KC Anatomical Society.

Series 12: Burial/ Removal Permits, 1954-1967

This series contains scans of Burial or Removal Permits. They are arranged first by the hospital that issued them, then by date. Most, though not all, of these individuals were then buried at Leeds Cemetery. Originally, these scanned copies were three to a page, they were trimmed down to their individual scans so that they could be arranged.

Subseries 12.1: Wheatley Provident, 1958

This subseries contains a Burial or Removal Permit from Wheatley Provident Hospital.

Subseries 12.2: Queen of the World, 1955-1959

This subseries contains two Burial or Removal Permits from Queen of the World Hospital.

Subseries 12.3: Undetermined, 1955-1967

This subseries contains Burial or Removal Permits where the hospital was not listed or not or unclear.

Subseries 12.4: General Hospital No. 1, n.d., 1955-1961

This subseries contains Burial or Removal Permits from General Hospital No. 1

Subseries 12.5: General Hospital No. 2, n.d., 1954-1962

This subseries contains Burial or Removal Permits from General Hospital No. 2.

Subseries 12.6: St. Vincent's Hospital, 1955

This subseries contains a Burial or Removal Permit from St. Vincent's Hospital.

Subseries 12.7: KC's Tuberculosis Hospital, 1955

This subseries contains a Burial or Removal Permit from KC's Tuberculosis Hospital.

Series 13: Permits, 1981-1983

This series contains permits for the disposition of human remains issued by Jackson County, unlike Series 12, which was issued by institutions.
