## *Biographical Sketch*

William L. Fambrough, Sr., (1916-1983) was a staff photographer for *The Call* during the 1950s and 1960s and worked as a freelance photographer throughout the Kansas City metropolitan area.

## *Scope and Content Note*

The images – both prints and digital images – are arranged numerically by image number and are organized into the following broad subject areas:

Buildings: Images 1-24 show buildings and building construction and destruction.

Businesses: Images 25-95 show businesses. Businesses depicted include The Call, Costello's Café, De Angelos Restaurant, Don Wright Midwest Motors, Green Duck's DX Service Station, Hurst's Diamond Shop, KPRS, Little Caesar's Lounge, Lou's Pharmacy, Palace Cab Company, Thamon Hayes Appliances and Furniture, and Watkins Brothers Funeral Home, among others.

Cars / Car Accidents: Images 96-101 show cars and car accidents.

Children: Images 102-161 show babies and children. Included in this category are images of children at community centers and vacation bible schools, children playing, and portraits of children.

Christmas: Images 162-166 show Christmas trees and a nativity scene.

Churches: Images 167-214 show churches and church functions.

Civil Rights: Images 215-269 show civil rights workers and activities. Included in this category are images of Kansas Citizens preparing to attend the March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom and the campaign for the 1964 Public Accommodations Ordinance.

Civil Service: Images 270-284 show firefighters, police officers, and other civil servants.

Dwellings: Images 285-314 show houses, apartment buildings, housing projects, and other human dwellings. Included in this category are photographs of the construction and opening of Parade Park Homes.

Entertainers / Entertainment: Images 315-367 show local and national entertainers and people being entertained in various venues.

Funerals: Images 368-377 show funerals.

Groups: Images 378-643 show groups of people. This category is sub-divided into photographs taken at The Call and those taken elsewhere and then into photographs of groups of men, groups of women, and mixed groups.

Health / Welfare: Images 644-675 show doctors, nurses, and other health care workers, medical and welfare institutions, and depictions of social welfare. Included in this category are images of nursing students at Queen of the World Hospital, the board of directors for the Florence Home, and images of food collection and distribution.

Individuals: Images 676-916 show individuals. This category is sub-divided into photographs taken at The Call and those taken elsewhere and then into photographs of men and women.

Local Government / Institutions: Images 917-941 depict municipal business and local institutions, including the Kansas City Public Library and Kansas City Zoo.

Organizations: Images 942-1018 show identified secular and religious organizations. Included are images of the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters, the Central-Linwood Community Council, the Congress of Church Youths, Frontiers International of Greater Kansas City, the Kansas Conference on Civil Rights, the Missouri Pan-Medical Association, the Paseo YWCA, the United Packinghouse Food & Allied Workers, and the Urban League of Greater Kansas City, among others.

Parades: Images 1019-1030 depict parades.

Politicians / Politics: Images 1031-1061 show politicians and electoral politics. Included in this category are photographs of the 1960 presidential campaign and visits by Henry Cabot Lodge, Lyndon Johnson, Richard Nixon, and Adam Clayton Powell. The images also depict local politicians, included Richard Bolling, Lewis W. Clymer, Ilus Davis, Edward V. Long, James McKinley Neal, and Henry Ross among others.

Protests / Picketing: Images 1062-1084 depict people protesting and picketing. Included are images of the NAACP Youth Council picketing outside the Kansas City Board of Education building and Firefighters Local No. 42 picketing outside City Hall.

Schools: Images 1085-1227 show schools, students, teachers, administrators, and school sports.

Science Fairs: Images 1228-1255 depict science fair exhibits.

Scouting: Images 1256-1271 show scouts and scouting organizations.

Sports: Images 1272-1348 depict various professional and amateur sports and sporting events. Included in this category are images of baseball, basketball, bowling, boxing, golf, and football. Images also include Jackie Robinson at Municipal Stadium and the Kansas City Chiefs.

Weddings / Anniversaries: Images 1349-1371 show weddings and anniversary celebrations.

Miscellaneous: Images 1372-1375 depict miscellaneous things. Included are images of an unidentified empty room, an old trailer, a cat and dog, and an unidentified lake.

The collection also includes an optical disc of images produced by Don Motley and Ray Doswell in 2004-2005 using the same negatives.
